Irregular verbs

Regular AR verbs - all regular AR verbs Will follow the patterns you see here

Root changing verbs - generally regular but with a spelling change in places.

Regular ER/IR verbs - all regular ER/IR verbs Will follow the patterns you see here.

When doing the higher tier, it's essential that you at least RECOGNISE the endings for other subjects (people) - It would also be great if you could learn them to use in your writing and speaking!
